

# **Campout Rules**

## **Supervision**

- Woodlands Trail boys must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or sibling/relative age 18+.
  - Quick errands are okay, but notify a Leader before leaving.
- Navigators/Adventurers may camp without a parent/guardian if at least two Leaders are aware.

## **Sleeping Arrangements**

- Foxes (ages 5–6) and Hawks (ages 7–8) must share a tent with a parent, guardian, or sibling age 18+.
- Mountain Lions (ages 9–10), Navigators, and Adventurers may sleep in their own tents.
- No hammocks allowed.
- No entering another person's tent.

## **Safety & Conduct**

- Closed-toe shoes required at all times.
- No running after dark. All Trailmen must carry and use a flashlight when outside after dark.
- Restrooms have no light—bring a flashlight.

## **Respect for Others**

- Apply sunscreen/bug spray only to your own Trailman.
- Do not take food or drinks from others' coolers, tables, or boxes without permission.

## **Tools & Fire Safety**

- Pocketknives: only trained Mountain Lions (with Woodsman card), Navigators, Adventurers, and adults may carry.
- Hatchets/Axes: Navigators, Adventurers, and adults only.
- Campfire: only trained Mountain Lions (with Fireguard card), Navigators, Adventurers, and adults may add wood.
