

American Heritage Girls and Trail Life USA Troop GA-2016 want to make certain our youth's privacy is not being shared on social media platforms without permission.

- AHG/TL members' personal information (last names, addresses, phone numbers, school, etc.) must not be shared without the parent or guardian's permission.
- Photos or videos of AHG/TL youth must not be shared without the parent or guardian's permission.
- Youth social media personal profiles must not be tagged or linked without parent or guardian's permission.
- Any content that could compromise the safety, security or privacy of AHG/TL members and non-members must not be shared.
- Sensitive content should not be shared in real-time including troop locations, dates, schedules, or activities.
- When posting about AHG/TL, do so with positive representations and reflecting AHG Oath and Creed and TL Oath and Motto.
- When posting about AHG/TL, do so with AHG/TL Health and Safety Policies and Guidelines in mind.
- All communication online with youth must be public and following two-deep leadership per AHG/TL policies.
- All AHG/TL Troop GA-2016 social media accounts, websites and applications must be managed and monitored by designated, trained AHG/TL leadership.
 - Pictures and information must only be shared on websites, platforms and apps that are closed to the public and information can be viewed only by invited members.
 - Invited members must not share information, photos, or videos from the private platforms to public social media platforms and must adhere to the above policies.
