AHG/TL Troop GA-2016 Safety Procedures

The following procedures have been installed as a part of our Troop to ensure the safety of all participants.

• Restrooms - Registered Youth

o All registered youth are proceed to the restroom in groups of three

Restrooms - Unregistered youth & all adults (registered or unregistered)

- All must use a separate restroom in the church building
- When only one restroom is available, registered youth must enter/exit while no unregistered youth or any adult (registered or unregistered).

1st Aid Kits

- 1st aid kits will be present at all events
 - Church closet behind pulpit
 - Events 1st aid kits will be brought by leadership

Medical Forms

- Youth must have a completed medical form registered with the troop
- Adults/non-registered youth must have a completed form on file with the troop before attending any events (sanctioned or unsanctioned) outside of the regular Monday night troop meeting.

Underaged Youth

Underaged youth may not participate in Troop meetings.

Parental watch before and after meetings

- Parents are responsible for their youth leading up to the start of the troop meeting as well as after the troop meeting has closed.
- AHG/TL leadership is not responsible for any youth activities taking place prior to or after the close of the meeting.

• Sign In/ Sign Out Sheet

 Parents/Guardians or registered youth must sign his/her youth in at the beginning of each troop meeting and sign the child out after each troop meeting. A sign in/sign out form will be placed at the entrance of the church before each troop meeting.

This is a brief description of the safety procedures Troop GA-2016 has in place. It is the responsibility of all leadership, parents and guardians to keep our youth safe!
